Mills

Producing the basis for paper packaging

- Produce containerboard, boxboard, and kraft paper
- Majority use 100% recycled content

Converters

Converting paper into packaging

- Producing the recyclable products we're familiar with:
 - Corrugated (cardboard) boxes
 - Paperboard (cereal, cracker) boxes
 - Paper bags (sugar, flour)

Customers

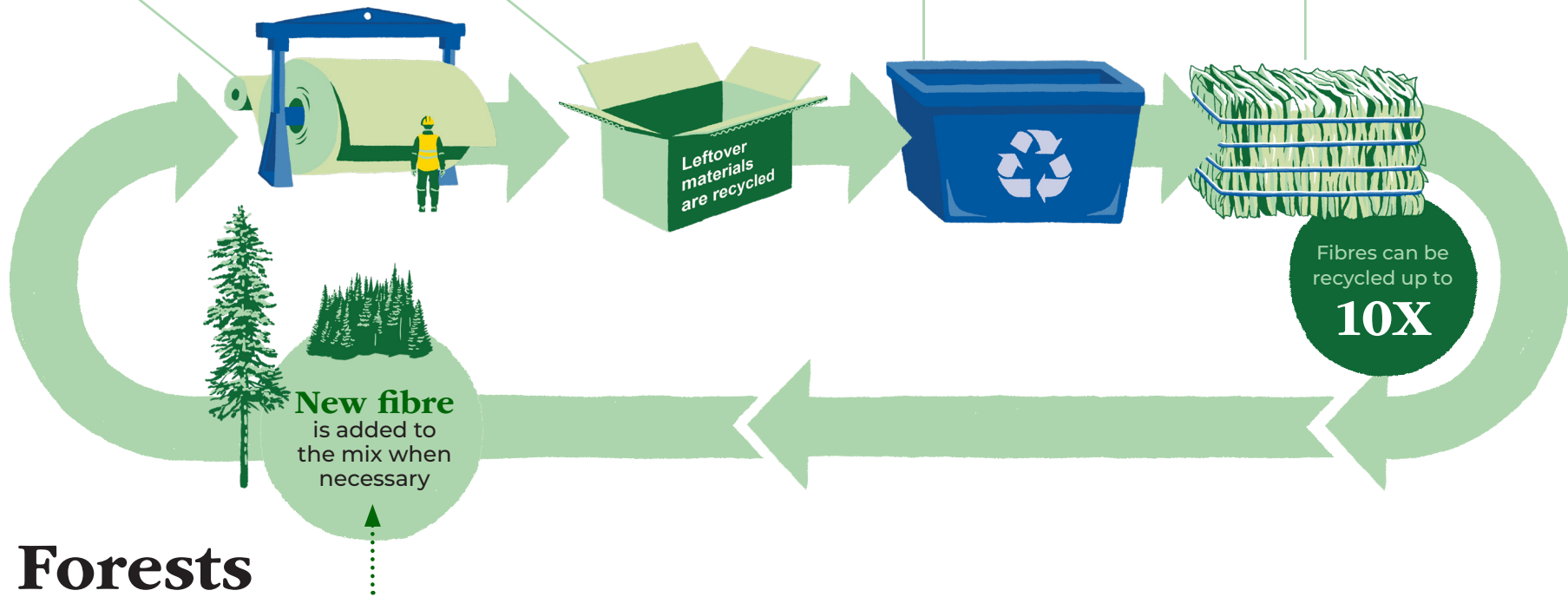
Returning paper packaging back to the circular recycling loop

- Commercial (retail, grocery, office)
- Industrial (foodservice, manufacturing)
- Residential (Blue Box)

Recyclers

Recovering and recycling paper packaging

- Materials are collected, sorted, bailed, and sent back to the mills



Forests

Sustainably managed forests

- Every hectare of commercial forest harvested in Canada must be regenerated
- < 0.5% harvested for paper packaging annually
